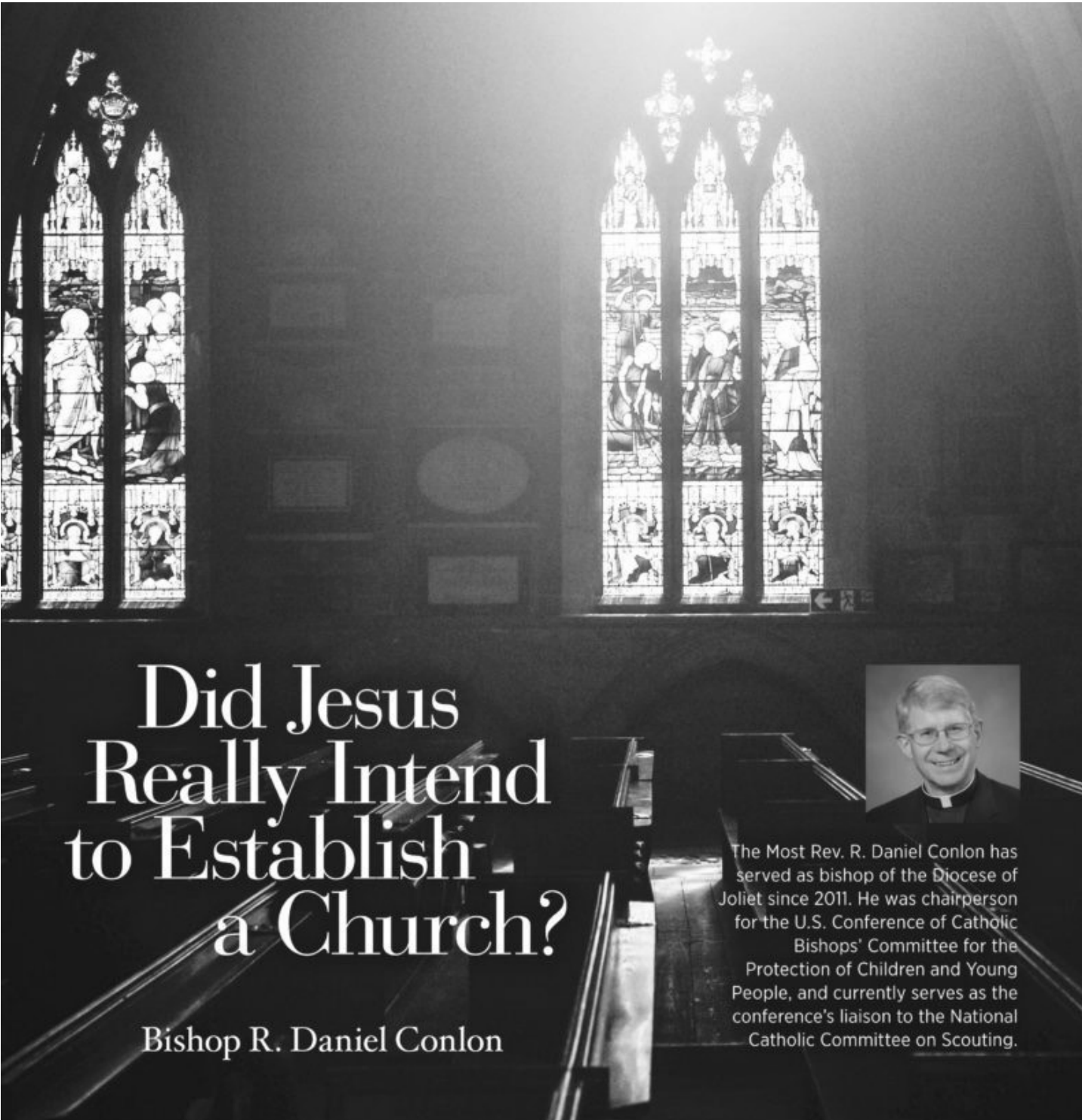

CATHOLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TUITION ASSISTANCE

Through the Catholic Education Foundation

The Catholic Education Foundation (CEF) welcomes applications for need-based tuition assistance grants for 2019-2020 school year to *elementary and secondary school students enrolled in Diocese of Joliet schools. Students entering Kindergarten through Grade 12 are eligible.*

**The CEF grant application timeline is
January 31 through March 1, 2019.**

These tuition assistance grants are determined on an annual basis and families must apply each year in order to be considered. In 2018-19, the CEF distributed \$2.2 million to 1,676 students in our Catholic elementary and high schools.

Families needing financial assistance must complete an application form and submit the \$35 application fee to the FACTS Company.

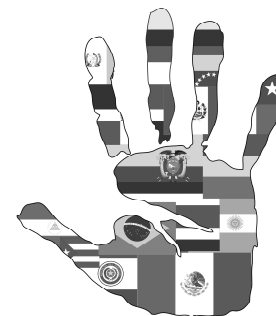

BAPTISMS

Baptisms are scheduled on the 1st and 3rd Sundays of the month at 12:15pm. Participation in our Parent Preparation Program, held on the 1st Tuesday of the month at 7:30pm, is mandatory before the baptism of the child. Call the Parish Office to schedule a baptism.

WEDDINGS

All weddings are scheduled by the Pastor and will be confirmed. Couples desiring to be married need to speak directly with the Pastor BEFORE reserving a hall. Only the Bride or Groom may request a date for their wedding. Diocese policy requires that a 6 month (minimum) preparation process be completed prior to the celebration of all weddings. Weddings are not scheduled on Sundays.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

Parishioners who are seriously ill or have surgery scheduled should receive the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Call the Parish Office to request this sacrament. Hospitalized or homebound parishioners desiring a pastoral visit should call the Parish Office.
